




WHERE TO PUT THE LOGO

The Jazz South logo works best in the top right hand corner of the page. Please place the logo here whenever practical.

The second best option is the bottom right hand corner.



GIMMIE SOME ROOM FOLKS



An exclusion zone that is at least the height of the 'J' should be left on all sizes of the logo between it and the nearest object.





Squash the logo out of proportion. (Most computer programs will allow you to hold SHIFT whilst scaling an object to prevent this from happening.)



Place the logo over busy backgrounds or images that will affect readability.



Place the logo too close to other items. (See previous page for exclusion zone.)



Use non-brand colours

Please don't do any of the things on this page so that together, we can make sure that no logos are harmed in the making of your visual identity.



Don't use the icon on its own instead of the logo.



Add any effects, drop shadows, texture, or edit the logo in any other way.

TYPE TO USE

Files used on the web

Web images are typically 72 dpi (dots, or pixels, per inch), making them load quickly, but will not replicate very well in print.

PNG files –

PNG images have a transparent background and will show anything you place underneath. (Please see note on previous page about not using the logo over busy backgrounds.)

Files used in print

Print images are typically 300 dpi and will print correctly every time



EPS or Ai files

If someone asks for a vector file, an EPS or Ai file is what you are looking for. These files are transparent and can be enlarged without losing its' quality. They will also have the correct colours to replicate correctly.

Please note you might not be able to read EPS and Ai files, don't worry if you can't open these files.

Other file formats _

We might also supply you with the following file formats: PDF and TIFF

These files can be used in print and can be viewed on PCs. We recommend you use EPS first unless the printer or designer specified an alternative.



The Jazz South pattern is designed for use to create impact using the visual identity of the brand in context where we don't want to use a photo and where minimal copy is required. This might be on banners, merchandise, beer mats, the inside pages of brochures and in physical settings such as on livery. The pattern may also be useful in digital settings, especially if animation can be applied.






GRAPHIC Backgrounds
